### **Vendor Rules & Requirements:**

1. You must provide your own tent/canopy. Only tent stakes 6" and under are allowed. One table and chair will be provided if needed (additional are available for an extra cost).
2. There are no refunds after the July 19<sup>th</sup> registration deadline!
3. Doors open promptly at 9:00am and you are expected to stay until closing time on BOTH days! NO EARLY BREAKDOWNS!
4. Set-up is Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup> after 2:00pm or after 7:00am each day of the event.
5. If you will require more space, you MUST reserve and pay for it in advance. You have the opportunity to include how many spaces you need on the registration form.
- 6. Absolutely no animals of any kinds are allowed on the State Park grounds.**
7. No baking or cooking allowed in craft tents. However, your previously baked & prepared items may displayed for sale.
8. We do provide overnight security. You are welcome to leave your wares , however it does get quite damp overnight and we do suggest that any water sensitive items be stored in airtight containers or toted off with you for the night. We do require that you sign the waiver at the bottom of the registration form regarding lost or damaged goods.
- 9. There is NO driving on the Fort grounds. You must park by the Fort wall to unload.**
